WHEREAS, the county and city experienced extreme weather conditions over the winter which has disrupted the lives and often isolated our citizens; and


WHEREAS, in meeting the challenges of these difficult times, including snow, flood, and extreme cold, countless acts of individual and organizational service have occurred; and

WHEREAS, we are inspired by the way our entire community mobilized in taking care and supporting others; and


WHEREAS, individual acts of service are at the center of what makes Bingham County and Blackfoot such a great place to live; and
