WHEREAS, we affirm the danger of not having children restrained or in the correct car seat; and

WHEREAS, the Blackfoot Police Department has a certified Child Passenger Safety Technician who is committed to educating parents and caregivers about the best ways to keep kids safe while traveling; and

WHEREAS, we are committed to enforcing the importance of preventing child deaths and injuries by keeping children buckled up in an appropriate car seat or seat belt; and

WHEREAS, the Blackfoot Police Department currently has convertible and booster seats available and conducts car seat inspection, both free of charge to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Paul M. Loomis, Mayor of the City of Blackfoot do hereby proclaim, 17 to 23 September 2017 as "NATIONAL CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY WEEK." I call on all in the City of Blackfoot to assist in this effort by encouraging and supporting the use of booster and car seats, to eliminate injuries and deaths in our community.
